When & Where?

The 2013 UBAWA Fall Book Fair will take place at the Georgia International Convention Center on September 28, 2013.

What can I expect to see?

What else will take place at the event?

We will be doing author interviews which will be recorded for selection in our DVD Documentary. An author panel will take place which will allow 7-9 authors the chance to share their experiences and unique perspectives on their road to becoming an author.

How Will the Event Be Marketed & Promoted?

The event is being marketed and advertised to attract thousands of residents living across the Metro Atlanta area through word of mouth and via radio and print advertisements. Atlanta is very diverse in its make-up so there will be a variety of groups representing an eclectic mix of age groups, socio-economic standings, and nationalities in attendance. We define "urban" to extend to all races and ethnicities, including African-American, Hispanic, Caucasian, refugees, Asian, Jewish, first generation immigrants, etc. We are reaching out to all demographics in the metro Atlanta area to include college students, the working class, youth, urban professionals, veterans and retired persons. The UBAWA Fall Book Fair is also being promoted and advertised through the Dekalb County and Fulton County libraries.

Reserving a Booth at the 2013 Fall Book Fair

Our first annual book fair will take place on September 28, 2013 at the Georgia International Convention Center in Atlanta, Georgia. Single booths are \$100 and include a 10 foot table and one chair. Double booths are \$150 and include a 10 foot

table and 2 chairs. Publishing companies and groups with 3 or more authors can reserve a booth for \$250 which includes a 10 foot table and 3-4 chairs. Author booths will be grouped according to genre.

We encourage all authors or non-book vendors interested in attending to reserve and purchase their booths as soon as possible, since we have only made room for 110 tables (75 single booths; 25 double booths; and 10 publishing company/group booths).
